CHAPTER 345.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 78B of Article 22 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Washington County," sub-title "Collector of Taxes."

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 78B of Article 22 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Washington County," sub-title "Collector of Taxes," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments so as to read as follows:

Section 78B. On the Tuesday after the first Monday in November, in the year nineteen hundred and fifteen, and on the same day every second year thereafter, there shall be elected by the qualified voters of Washington County a Tax Collector, who shall hold office for two years from the first day of April next ensuing his election, and be subject to removal therefrom for incompetency, willful neglect of duty or misdemeanor in office on conviction in a court of law. No one shall be elected Tax Collector who shall not be above twenty-one years of age and five years a resident of Washington County, Maryland, and in case of a vacancy in the office of Tax Cold lector in consequence of death, resignation, removal, disqualifigation or failure to properly qualify, the Governor shall fill said vacancy as soon thereafter as practicable; the said Tax Collector shall perform and fulfill all the duties and functions. and be subject to all the obligations, requirements and limitations that are now, or may hereafter be defined, imposed or required by any general law or statute of the State of Maryland, or any local law or statute for Washington County upon a Collector for Washington County for the collection of all State
