

taxes, appointed by the County Commissioners of Washington County under and in accordance with the provision of Section 33 of Article 81 of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Revenue and Taxes," sub-title "Collectors and Collections," all of which said laws, general and local, together with any future amendments thereto, being hereby made applicable to the Tax Collector to be elected as in this section provided; the compensation for said Tax Collector, elected as herein provided, to be the same as is now or may hereafter be provided by law for such collector appointed in conformity with said Section 33 of said Article 81, provided that said compensation shall not be less than that now paid to such collector. Until the election of a Tax Collector under the provisions of this Section the provisions of said Section 33 of said Article 81 of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland shall be and remain in full force and effect, the incumbent collector at the time of an election of a Tax Collector under the provisions of this Section to hold office until the commencement of the terms of office of the Tax Collector elected under the provisions of this Section. Nothing herein contained shall be taken to relieve any retiring collector, or Tax Collector, from the duty of collecting after the expiration of his term of office the taxes levied during the term of office of such retiring collector, or Tax Collector. The County Commissioners of Washington County shall pay the premiums upon the bond required of the Tax Collector elected under the provisions of this Section.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the first day of June, 1918.
