

organization, provided that in all cases mentioned in this section the officer serving process shall leave a copy thereof with the person upon whom it is served; such action shall have the same force and effect, as regards the common property, rights and liabilities of such association or organization only, as if it were prosecuted by or against all the members thereof, and such action shall not abate by reason of the death, resignation, removal or legal incapacity of any officer or member of such association or organization, or by reason of any change in the membership thereof. Such association or organization may be sued in any county or in the City of Baltimore, as the case may be, where its principal office is located, or where it regularly meets or transacts business, or in a local action where the subject matter thereof lies.

CHAPTER 422.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Sections 293 and 294 of Article 27 of Bagby's Edition of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Crimes and Punishments," sub-title "Larceny—Horses," and providing penalties for the larceny of motor vehicles.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Sections 293 and 294 of Article 27 of Bagby's Edition of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland; title "Crimes and Punishments," sub-title "Larceny—Horses," be and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:
