Gumbert, late of Washington County, deceased, unto Consistory of Zion Reformed Church of Hagerstown, the income of which is to be used in keeping the graveyard in repair and good condition, said Will being of record in "Wills," Liber "M," folio 399, etc., one of the record books in the office of the Register of Wills for Washington County.
