

perform such other duties as the Commission may designate, including the guarding of streams and waters of the State against pollution.

Section 47. The Conservation Commission shall issue to each person so appointed as deputy or local game warden a commission, and transmit such commission to the clerk's office of the Circuit Court for the county in which the deputy game warden so appointed has his legal residence, or to the office of the clerk of the Court of Common Pleas of Baltimore City, if residing in Baltimore City, and they may revoke and annul any such appointment at their pleasure.

Section 56. All Sheriffs, Constables and Police Officers and all the officers appointed by the Conservation Commission shall assist in enforcing the provisions of this Article, and shall have all the powers of a deputy game warden. The game warden and the deputy game wardens and any other officers shall not be liable for any damage or costs sustained by any person or corporation by reason of the wrongful seizure of game, wild life or fish under this sub-title; provided, however, that the enforcement of this sub-title shall in no wise prevent prosecution of persons or corporations for violations of the game, wild life or fish laws of this State.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That Sections 38 and 51 of said Article 99 be and the same are hereby repealed, except as to cases pending at the time of the passage of this Act.

SEC. 3. *And be it further enacted*, That five new sections be and they are hereby added to said Article 99, to follow Section 66 and to be known as Sections 67, 68, 69, 70 and 71 of said Article, and to read as follows:

Section 67. For the purpose of providing a fund for the payment of the expenses of protecting and propagating certain birds and animals, and preventing unauthorized persons from killing the same, no person or persons shall at any time hunt, pursue or kill in any manner any game as defined in Section 44 of this Article, without first having procured a license and the written permission from the property owner or tenant on whose property said person may be hunting to so hunt, pursue or kill, and then only during the respective periods of the year when it shall be lawful to hunt, pursue or kill birds and animals. The said license shall be procured from the Clerk of the Circuit Court of any County or from the Clerk of the
