year shall be paid by the Board of Water Commissioners to the Mayor and Council of Hagerstown, to be appropriated by said Mayor and Council toward the purchase in the open market of any of the bonds authorized to be issued or assumed under the provisions of this Act for the purpose of redeeming the same and any bonds so purchased shall forthwith be cancelled.

- SEC. 7. And be it further enacted, That in addition to the powers expressly conferred by this Act, the Mayor and Council of Hagerstown shall have such other powers as are incident thereto, or a necessary consequence of the powers herein conferred, which shall include the right to pass all ordinances not inconsistent with the powers granted by this Act, that may be deemed necessary for the proper preservation and protection of said plant, its waters, streams of water and water supplies and to attach reasonble penalties for violation thereof, to formulate, and enforce all rules and regulations necessary for the proper conduct of the business of said plant, and from time to time to repeal, alter and amend said ordinances and said rules and regulations.
- SEC. 8. And be it further enacted, That if any claim for service of water, or water rent, shall remain in arrears against any consumer for a period of thirty days, or in case any consumer shall violate any of the rules and regulations relating to said Water Plant which may be passed by the said Mayor and Council, the "Board of Water Commissioners" shall have the right to cut off the supply of water from said consumer, after notice.
- SEC. 9. And be it further enacted, That the Mayor and Council of Hagerstown is hereby authorized and empowered to borrow the sum of money necessary to pay the amount of the purchase price fixed by the Public Service Commission of Maryland under the provisions of this Act, and such amount in addition thereto as may be added under the provisions of Section 13 of this Act, as well as any money that may be necessary from time to time to enlarge and extend said plant after purchase thereof and to provide such working capital as may be necessary in the opinion of the Mayor and Council, upon the faith and credit of Hagerstown hereinafter provided, and to issue and sell bonds to raise said sum or sums of money or so much thereof as may be necessary, which issue of bonds shall be known and designated as "Water Bonds" and the money arising from the sale thereof shall be applied exclusively
