Yarnall, late of the City of Philadelphia Pennsylvania, deceased, to the Sisters of Charity of Mount Hope Retreat, situated in Baltimore County, State of Maryland.

38. To the deed and grant made by John F. Carter and wife to the Methodist Protestant Church Extension Society of Baltimore City, of a certain lot of ground situated in Baltimore County, particularly described in said deed, dated the 30th
