be construed to import both the plural and singular, as the case demands, and shall include corporations, companies, societies and associations; when construing and enforcing the provisions of this Act, the act, omission or failure of any officer, agent or other person acting for or employed by any corporation, company or society, or association, shall in every case be also deemed to be the act, omission or failure of such corporation, company, society or association, as well as that of the person.

Sec. 140n. That Sections 221 and 222 of Article 27 of the Code of Public General Laws of 1904, title "Crimes and Punishments," subtitle "Health: Deleterious Candy or Cakes," and Sections 122, 123, 124 and 125 of Article 43 of the Code of Public General Laws of 1904, title "Health," subtitle "Adulteration of Food and Drink," and all other Acts and parts of Acts inconsistent with this Act be and the same are hereby repealed.

SEC. 1400. This Act shall be in force and effect from and after July 1st, 1910, but shall not apply to foods and drugs purchased by the dealers prior to the passage of this Act until January 1st, 1911; provided, that after January 1st, 1911, any such original package of foods or drugs in possession of any manufacturer or dealer so purchased and delivered before the passage of this Act may be sold, if such original packages are labeled with a sticker, supplemental label or imprint, under the provisions of this Act; and provided further, that the contents of such package conform to the requirements and provisions of this Act.

CHAPTER 494.

AN ACT to repeal Sections 144 and 147 of Article 43 of the Public General Laws, title "Health," sub-title "Commissioners of Pharmacy," as said sections were enacted by Chapter 179 of the Acts of 1902, and amended by Chapter 585 of the Acts of 1906, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sections 144 and 147 of Article 43 of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Health," sub-title "Commissioners of Pharmacy," as said sections were enacted by Chapter 179 of the Acts of 1902 and amended by Chapter 585 of the Acts of 1906, be and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments, so as to read as follows:
