

## ARTICLE LXXVI.

## PUBLICATION OF LAWS.

## CHAPTER 345.

AN ACT to provide for the examination, adoption and publication of the Criminal Code of the State of Maryland, containing the Articles and sections of the present Code of Public General Laws of 1904, and the subsequent Public General Laws in force on the first Wednesday of January, in the year nineteen hundred and ten, so far as they relate to crimes and impose a penalty therefor, as codified by the Commissioners for the Revision of the Criminal Law of the State of Maryland, and submitted to this General Assembly by said Commission in pursuance of the Act of 1908, Chapter 325, entitled "An Act to provide for the appointment by the Governor of this State of a commission of three persons to revise the Criminal Law of the State, and providing compensation for said Commission and a fund to defray the necessary expenses thereof;" and providing for the codification of the Public General Laws enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland at its Session of 1910 relating to crimes and punishments and the incorporation thereof in said Criminal Code.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Criminal Code of the State of Maryland, containing the Articles and sections of the present Code of Public General Laws of 1904, and the subsequent Public General Laws in force on the first Wednesday of January, in the year nineteen hundred and ten, so far as they relate to crimes and impose penalties therefor, revised and codified by the Commission for the Revision of the Criminal Law of the State of Maryland, and submitted to this General Assembly by said Commission, in pursuance of Chapter 325 of the Acts of 1908, entitled "An Act to provide for the appointment by the Governor of this State of a commission of three persons to revise the criminal law of the State, and providing compensation for said Commission and a fund to defray the necessary expenses thereof," with the Public General Laws enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland at its session of 1910 relating to crimes and punishments incorporated therein, shall be printed and submitted by said commission to the commission to be appointed by the Court of Appeals under the provisions of Section 7 of Article 80 of the Code of Public General Laws, to examine and approve the new Code of Public General Laws of the State of Maryland directed by the provisions of said Article to be prepared by the State Reporter and Codifier, for their
