COMMISSION'S ACCOUNTS AUDITED BIENNIALLY.

SEC. 51. And be it further enacted, That it shall be the duty of the State Auditor to make biennial examinations and audits, comprehensive and thorough in character, of all the receipts, expenditures, costs, expenses and pecuniary or fiscal affairs or concerns of the said Public Service Commission, to render and furnish to the Governor, the Comptroller and the Treasurer, respectively, a full and detailed report of each of said biennial examinations and audits, the first of said biennial reports to be delivered to said officials, respectively, upon the first day of January, and the second of said reports to be delivered to said officials upon the first day of July of each and every year ensuing the passage of this Act.

MISCELLANEOUS.

- SEC. 52. And be it further enacted, That the Public Service Commission hereby created shall have, in addition to the powers herein specified, mentioned or indicated, all additional, implied and incidental powers, which may be proper and necessary to effectually carry out, perform and execute all the said powers herein specified, mentioned or indicated.
- SEC. 53. And be it further enacted, That the provisions of this Act shall apply to services or utilities rendered by any of the corporations subject to the provisions of this Act, or any of the same, within the State of Maryland, and nothing in this Act contained shall be deemed or construed to apply to or operate upon interstate or foreign commerce.
- SEC. 54. And be it further enacted, That each section of this Act and every part of each section are hereby declared to be independent sections, and the holding of any section or sections, or part or parts thereof, to be void, ineffective or unconstitutional for any cause, shall not be deemed to affect any other section or part thereof.
- SEC. 55. And be it further enacted, That all Acts and parts of Acts conflicting or inconsistent with any provision or provisions of this Act are hereby repealed so far as they conflict or are inconsistent with any provision or provisions of this Act.
- SEC. 56. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
