

ARTICLE V.

CALVERT COUNTY.

CHAPTER 290.

AN ACT to repeal Section 10 of Chapter 622 of the Acts of 1908, entitled "An Act to provide for the repairs of the public roads of Calvert County," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 10 of Chapter 622 of the Acts of 1908, entitled "An Act to provide for the repairs of the public roads of Calvert County," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

SEC. 10. That the said Road Commissioners shall each receive from the County Commissioners one hundred (\$100) dollars, per annum, for the performance of the duties of this office.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 395.

AN ACT to incorporate the town of North Beach, in Calvert County, Maryland.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the inhabitants of North Beach, in Calvert County, Maryland, be and they are hereby incorporated and created a corporate body, under the name and by the style of "The Town of North Beach," and by that name may sue and be sued and have and use a common seal, and have perpetual succession.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the boundary limits of said town of North Beach shall be as follows: So much as lies east of the west line of Detroit avenue in that tract of land situate, lying and being in Calvert County, in the State of Maryland, and heretofore called North Chesapeake Beach, as appears by plat recorded among the Land Records of Calvert County, aforesaid, in Liber G. W. D., No. 1, folio 497; and also including the waters abutting thereon eastward for a distance of 2,000 feet; and said town shall have and exercise full police powers within the limits of said town and for a distance of one thousand feet beyond the land boundaries thereof.
