

SEC. 4. *Be it further enacted*, That said constables shall hold said office at the pleasure of said County Commissioners, and shall be removed, transferred or assigned or dismissed at the pleasure of said County Commissioners.

SEC. 5. *Be it further enacted*, That the County Commissioners of aforesaid are hereby authorized and empowered to annually levy the sum of two thousand dollars each and every year, and shall pay to said constables so appointed under the provisions of this Act such sum or sums of money as said Commissioners shall deem just and proper for service performed by said constables.

SEC. 6. *Be it further enacted*, That any and all Acts inconsistent with this Act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 7. *Be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

#### CHAPTER 672.

AN ACT to authorize and direct the County Commissioners of Montgomery County to borrow money for the use of the Board of County School Commissioners of said county in providing certain facilities for public school purposes in said county and to issue bonds of said county for the money so borrowed of the par value of twelve thousand dollars.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Board of County School Commissioners of Montgomery County be and is hereby authorized to erect and equip in its discretion, in the town of Damascus and at or near the village of Germantown, or elsewhere in said Montgomery county, such public school building or buildings in addition or additions to Public School building or buildings as the said Board of County School Commissioners may deem necessary or desirable, and if need be, to purchase the fee simple title to suitable tract or tracts of land for Public School purposes.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That for the purposes of this Act, the County Commissioners of said county be, and they are hereby authorized and directed to pay to the Board of County School Commissioners of said county, the sum of twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000) together with such additional sum as may be derived from the sale of the bonds hereinafter provided for.
