

It is, therefore, essential that an intelligent, broad minded and liberal colored man or woman be a member of the School Board, in order that when problems arise concerning the colored people, the Board may be able to have the benefit of official and intimate and intelligent counsel. It is obvious, then, that this one of the many possible illustrations will benefit the Board and the Community.

4. We understand that appointments are to be made in March of alternate years. We are prepared to assist in nominating a colored citizen, adequately qualified, one who is an educator, a broad minded person who will be an asset to the Board and to the city. If His Honor desires it, the Association for the Handicapped will send him a full biographical sketch of its nominee for his consideration.

5. A large number of colored organizations, churches and individuals are cooperating with our Association. We also have a large representation of fair-minded white people who are backing us, including churches, organizations and individuals.

6. The Association for the Handicapped and all allied organizations have watched with interest the efficient and businesslike administration His Honor has given the citizens of Baltimore.
