ville, for the present year, authorized and empowered to collect the taxes imposed by the Commissioners for said town, and placed in the hands of James McNerhany for collection, so far as the same remains uncollected by said McNerhany, and the official bond of said Miller responsible for the collection and payment over of said taxes, in the same manner and to the same extent as if the same had gone into his hands under an original assessment,

In all cases hereafter when the office of Chief Bailiff of said town shall become vacant from death, resignation or removal, the commissioners of said town to have authority to appoint some other person to complete the collection of any uncollected taxes due said corporation, and remaining uncollected, and the person so appointed to give a bond with security to be approved by the said commissioners for the faithful performance of his duties,

Authorised to collect all uncollected taxes due the commissioners, &c., and to pay the same within six months from his appointment,

Act to take effect from its passage,

Each judge of the Orphans' Court for said county to be paid \$3.00 for each day he shall attend to the duties of his office, and five cents per mile mileage, but no mileage returning,

To repeal the law requiring potatoes to be sold by weight in,

MORTGAGES—To authorise the affidavit required of Morgagees before sale to be made before certain persons,
