SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from and after the date of its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 20.

AN ACT to amend the fourth Article of the Code of Public Local Laws relating to the City of Baltimore by adding to the said Article the following section giving authority to the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to issue certificates of debt to an amount not exceeding five hundred thousand dollars, in addition to the amount authorized to be issued by section nine hundred and thirty-nine of said fourth Article. Passed May 11, 1861.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore shall have and are hereby given authority in the name of said city, to issue certificates of debt to an amount not exceeding five hundred thousand dollars, in addition to the amount authorized to be issued by section nine hundred and thirty-nine of said fourth Article, to be denominated upon their face "Baltimore Water Stock," and bearing interest not exceeding six per cent per annum, and to provide by ordinance for the redemption of the same at a certain time and under such provision as the Mayor and City Council may deem expedient and proper. Authority to issue certificates.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect immediately from and after its passage. In force.
