AN ACT to amend the sixty-fifth section of the Passed June Code of Public Local Laws, of Somerset county, 10, 1861. relating to Justices of the Peace and Constables, by adding thereto the following:

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly Addition of Maryland, That, in addition to the constables constable. heretofore authorized by law, in the election districtin Somerset county, wherein the town of Princess Anne is situated, there shall be one additional constable appointed by the commissioners of the county, who shall hold his office until the next regular election in this State; and that an additional constable shall then and thereafter be elected as other constables are elected.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That said additional constable shall be a resident of the town of Princess Anne, and it shall be his special duty, in addition to the ordinary duties of a constable to enforce the laws relating to free negroes, and slaves within the limits of said town.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That said constable said shall be paid by the county aforesaid, at the by county. discretion of the commissioners of said county, an annual compensation at a rate not exceeding two hundred dollars, to be levied upon the taxable property in said town of Princess Anne.
