CHAPTER 35.

AN ACT to repeal the four hundred and twelfth Section of Article four, of the Code of Public Local Laws relating to the inspection and weighing of hay, and to insert in lieu thereof the following sections: Passed June 11, 1861.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the four hundred and twelfth section of Article four, of the Code of Public Local Laws is hereby repealed, and the following substituted therefor: Repealed.

All hay and straw brought to the city of Baltimore shall be weighed at the State Hay Scales, as provided in this article, and by one of the Inspectors, at the rate of one hundred pounds to the hundred weight, making a reasonable allowance for the moisture thereof, as well as for the mud or other substances attached to the wagon, cart or sled containing the same; this section not to apply to hay or straw in bales brought to the city by water, rail road, wagons, carts or sleds. Weight.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.
