CHAPTER 38.

- AN ACT appropriating a sum of money for the Passed June payment of Outerbridge Horsey, for services 11, 1861. rendered, as Commissioner to the State of Virginia.
- SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly Authorised of Maryland, That the Treasurer be, and he is to pay. hereby directed to pay upon the warrant of the Comptroller, to Outerbridge Horsey, the sum of three hundred and fifty dollars, for services rendered and expenses incurred, as Commissioner to Virginia, under a joint resolution passed May third, eighteen hundred and sixty-one.
