CHAP. 62.

AN ACT authorizing the County Commissioners of Frederick county at their discretion, to purchase of Thomas H. O'Neal, for the use of said county, all the field notes, plats, Surveyor's Books, &c., now in his possession.

7, 1861.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the County Commissioners of Frederick county be and they are hereby authorized and empowered, in their discretion, to purchase from Thomas H. O'Neal, for the use of the said county, all his field notes, plats, Surveyor's Books, &c., at and for such sum or price as may be agreed upon between the said Commissioners and the said O'Neal; and in case said Commissioners shall determine to make said purchase, they shall levy upon the assessable property of said county the sum of money necessary to pay for the same.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the day of its passage.

CHAPTER 62.

AN ACT to amend the eighty-eighth section of Article seventh of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to Carroll county, by adding thereto the following:

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That any white person or persons, free negro or slave, who shall violate any of the penal ordinances, or any ordinance, or clause of any ordinance of the corporation of Uniontown, the violation of which, subjects the party violating the same to a fine, shall, immediately after the fine is imposed, pay the same, otherwise the said party
