CHAPTER 63.

Passed June AN ACT to legalize and make valid the acts, do-18. 1861. ings and proceedings of the Burgess and Commissioners of Uniontown, in Carroll county.

Preamble. Whereas doubts have arisen in regard to the legality of the acts, doings and proceedings of the Burgess and Commissioners of Uniontown, in Carroll county, because the election for said Burgess and Commissioners, was not held on the first Monday of April, as required by the eightythird section of Article seventh of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to Carroll county, Therefore,

Made valid. Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That all the acts, doings and proceedings of the Burgess and Commissioners of Uniontown, in Carroll county, be and the same are hereby legalized and made as valid and effectual as if the election for said Burgess and Commissioners had been held as required by said section.

In force. SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this act shall take effect from the day of its passage.
