

## CHAPTER 65.

## CHAP. 66.

AN ACT appropriating a sum of money to the Trustees of Chipewa Tribe, Number nineteen, Improved Order of Red Men. Passed June 25, 1861.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Treasurer is hereby required, on the warrant of the Comptroller, to pay the Trustees of Chipewa Tribe, Number nineteen, Improved Order of Red Men, the sum of one hundred dollars for rent of their hall for the use of the Senate, being balance of rent due for the May session. Authorised to pay.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That the Treasurer is hereby required to pay to said Trustees, on the warrant of the Comptroller, the sum of fifteen dollars per day, for the use of said hall by the Senate for the June session; and the Secretary of the Senate, at the close of said session, is hereby required to furnish the said Trustees a certificate of the number of days the Senate may have occupied said hall at its June session. Number of days.

SEC. 3. *And be it further enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.

## CHAPTER 66.

AN ACT making appropriations for the payment of the expenses of the extra-session of the General Assembly of Maryland. Passed June 25, 1861.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the following sums be and they are hereby appropriated, or so much thereof as may be necessary for the payment of the expenses of the extra-session of the General Assembly: For compensation granted by the Constitution and laws of this State to the Members of the Senate and House of Delegates, their officers and attendants, nineteen thousand eight hundred and forty dollars; for Appropriation.
