CHAPTER 83.

Passed Aug. 5, 1861. AN ACT to amend the ninety-third article, section two hundred and fifty-three of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to the bonds of Registers of Wills.

Repealed. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section two hundred and fifty-three, article ninety-three, of the Code of Public General Laws, be and the same is hereby repealed, and the following inserted in lieu thereof:

Bond. The Register of Wills, in each county, before he acts as such, shall give bond with two good and sufficient securities, in the penal sum of seven thousand dollars, payable to this State, conditioned for the faithful performance of his said office of Register of Wills, which bond shall be taken, and securities approved by the judges of the Orphans Court, and recorded in the office of the clerk of the Circuit Court, for the county in which the party so executing the bond shall live, or the Superior Court of Baltimore city, if Register of said city, and every Register shall renew his bond on or before the thirty-first day of December, in every second year.

In force. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from its passage.

Passed Aug. 2, 1861. A SUPPLEMENT to an Act entitled, an act to incorporate the Baltimore, Catonsville and Ellicott's Mills Passenger Railway Company passed at January session, 1860, chap. 34.

Authority to purchase lands. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Baltimore, Catonsville and Ellicott's Mills Passenger Railway Company may and shall be authorized to purchase and occupy,
