CHAPTER 91.

AN ACT appropriating a sum of money for the Passed Aug.
purpose of re-binding certain dockets and record 7, 1861.
books of the late High Court of Chancery.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the keeper of the Chancery Records be, and he is hereby authorised to have re-bound certain dockets and record books of the late High Court of Chancery of Maryland; *provided*, the cost thereof does not exceed the sum of sixty dollars. Authority to have rebound.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the Comptroller on the order of the keeper of the chancery records, is hereby directed to issue his warrant to the Treasurer for the payment of the said sum of sixty dollars or so much thereof as may be necessary. Warrant for payment.
