Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Governor be and he is hereby requested to direct the Adjutant General of this State to furnish to the President and Faculty of Washington College, seventy-five cadets' muskets and accoutrements, including percussion caps, together with twelve sergeants' swords and twelve lieutenants' swords, fit for parade, for the use of said college.

Assented to RESOLUTION appointing a Commissioner to the May 7, 1861.

Governor of Delaware in regard to the arming of Free Negroes on the Maryland line.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That John M. Robinson, be, and he is hereby appointed a Commissioner on the part of the State of Maryland, to communicate immediately with His Excellency, the Governor of Delaware, in regard to the arming the free negroes of Delaware along the Maryland line, and whether any arrangements can be made, consistent with the laws of Delaware and Maryland, calculated to allay the excitement of our people along the Maryland lines.
