Is contained in the following propositions, viz:

- I. The *vital* principle is contained in the *blood*.
- II. *Blood* makes *blood*.
- III. Every thing in the body is derived from the *blood*.
- IV. All constitutions are radically the same.
- V. All *diseases* arise from the *impurity* of the *blood*, or in other words, from the acrimonious humors lodged in the body.
- VI. This humor which degenerates the *blood* has three sources—the *maturnine*, the *contagious*, and the *personal*.
- VII. *Pain* and *disease* have the same origin: and may therefore be considered synonymous terms.
- VIII. PURGATION by the VEGETABLE UNIVERSAL MEDICINES, or other similar purgatives, is the only effectual mode of eradicating disease.
