CHAPTER 132.

A SUPPLEMENT to an act, entitled an act to Passed March 24, 1866. incorporate the American Fire Insurance Company of Baltimore, passed February twentythird, eighteen hundred and fifty-eight, chapter eighty.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Asseminsurance. May make insurance. bly of Maryland, That the American Fire Insurance Company of Baltimore, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered by instrument under seal or otherwise, to make insurance upon vessels, freight, goods, wares and merchandise, and to make all and every insurance appertaining to or connected with marine risks and risks of transportation and navigation.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That the said American Fire Insurance Company of Baltimore, shall capital. have power to increase their capital to an amount not exceeding five hundred thousand dollars.

Sec. 3. And be it enacted, That this supplement When in force. shall be in full force from the date of its acceptance by the stockholders of the said American Fire Insurance Company of Baltimore.

CHAPTER 133.

AN ACT, for the relief of James A. Deaver, an Passed March 24, 1866. indigent idiot of Harford county, by authorizing the County Commissioners of said county to levy a sum of money for his support.
