

and annually thereafter, so long as they may deem it necessary for his support, to levy on the assessable property in said county, a sum of money, not to exceed one hundred dollars, for the support and maintenance of James A. Deaver, an indigent idiot and resident of said county, to be paid to such person as shall have the care and custody of said idiot.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from and after the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 134.

Passed March
24, 1866.

A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT to the act entitled, "an act to incorporate the Mutual Fire Insurance Company of Cecil county," passed January thirtieth, eighteen hundred and forty-six.

Repealed.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That so much of the twelfth section of the original act, to which this is a supplement, as forbids the said corporation to purchase and sell any stock or funded debt created or to be created under any law of this State, or under any law of the United States, be and the same is hereby repealed.

May invest
accumulating
funds.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That managers of said corporation shall have authority to purchase as an investment of the funds accumulating in their hands, this State or United States securities as they may deem proper, and may sell and dispose of the same whenever the proceeds shall be needed to discharge the obligations of the corporation.

May issue
special policies

Sec. 3. *And be it enacted*, That the said corporation shall have power to issue special policies of insurance for limited periods from their date upon buildings in the course of construction or undergoing repairs, or upon the contents of farm build-
