CHAPTER 135.

AN ACT to amend and re-enact section twenty-one of Article forty-one of the Code of Public General Laws relating to "Fish and Fisheries." Passed March 24, 1865.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That section twenty-one of Article forty-one of the Code of Public General Laws relating to "Fish and Fisheries," under the head of "Potomac," be and the same is hereby amended and re-enacted so as to read as follows: Amended and re-enacted.

21. It shall not be lawful for any person, other than the owner or by the permission of the owner, to take or carry away from any shore of the Potomac river below Fort Washington which has been or may be used as a fishery, any sand, gravel or other matter that may form part of said shore to the amount of twenty bushels or more, and if any person shall feloniously steal, take and carry away from any shore of the Potomac river below Fort Washington, which has been or may be used as a fishery, any sand, gravel or other matter that may form part of said shore to the amount of twenty bushels or more, such person shall be deemed guilty of larceny, and on conviction thereof in the Circuit Court of the county in which such larceny was committed, shall pay to the owner the full Not lawful to carry away sand, gravel, &c.
