

made, the Governor shall issue commissions to the different persons elected, including the Lieutenant Governor, as provided in the fourteenth section of the fourth Article of the Constitution of this State.

32. The said certificates for all officers provided for by the Constitution, except in the case of Governor and State's Attorneys, shall be directed to the Governor; for the Governor they shall be addressed to the Speaker of the House of Delegates, and enclosed to the Secretary of State; for State's Attorneys they shall be addressed to the Judge of the court having criminal jurisdiction in the county or city.

52. All contested elections for Comptroller of the Treasury, Commissioner of the Land Office, Judges, Clerks of the Courts of law and Register of Wills, shall be decided by the House of Delegates, and the testimony shall be taken in such cases in the same manner as is herein prescribed in contested seats of the Senate or House of Delegates.

CHAPTER 144.

AN ACT to enable any bank, savings institution or savings bank of this State, to become an association for the purposes of banking under the laws of the United States.

Passed March
24, 1865.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That any bank, savings institution or savings bank incorporated under the laws of this State, may become an association for the purpose of banking under the laws of the United States; *provided,* it shall first comply with all the requirements of the act of the first session of the thirty-eighth Congress of the United States, entitled, "An act to provide a national currency, se-
