

bank, incurred prior to the surrender of its charter.

Plates and dies to be destroyed.

Sec. 5. *And be it further enacted*, That whenever the charter of any bank, savings institution or savings bank in the State has been surrendered, as hereinbefore provided for, the members of the Board of Directors, last in office, shall forthwith deliver up all the plates and dies of said bank, savings institution or savings bank to the Superior Court of Baltimore city, when said bank, savings institution or savings bank is located in the city, or to the Circuit Court for the county in which said bank, savings institution or savings bank may be located, and the Judge of each of said courts shall cause the said plates and dies to be destroyed in his presence, and also in the presence of the President or Cashier of said bank, savings institution or savings bank, and the members of Board of Directors, who wilfully refuse or neglect so to do, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction, shall be severally punished by a fine not exceeding five hundred dollars.

Sec. 6. *And be it further enacted*, That this act shall take effect from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 145.

Passed March 24, 1865. AN ACT to incorporate the Pocomoke Navigation Company.

Commissioners appointed.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That John R. Franklin, Seth M. Willy, Dr. Wm. H. Farrow, Dr. Andrew Stafford, E. K. Wilson, William H. Stafford and Robert S. Todd, be and they are hereby appointed Commissioners, under the direction of a majority of whom subscriptions may be received to the capital stock of the Pocomoke Navigation Company, for the purpose of surveying, removing obstructions and making navigable the Pocomoke river, from the town of Snow Hill to as near the
