## CHAPTER 153.

AN ACT appropriating a sum of money for services rendered the State by Daniel M. Moore and Job Haines, in the adjustment and payment of Claims for Bounty to Volunteers, under the acts for eighteen hundred and sixty-four, providing for the payment of Bounty to Volunteers.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Treasurer is hereby directed to pay on the warrant of the Comptroller, to Daniel M. Moore and Job Haines, the sum of three hundred dollars each, for services rendered the State in the examination and adjustment of claims for bounty to volunteers, this sum to be paid out of the unexpended portion of the appropriation made under chapter fifteen of eighteen hundred and sixty-four for the payment of bounty to volunteers enlisted from this State.
