

CHAPTER 168.

AN ACT supplementary to an act entitled, an act making appropriations for the support of the Government, for the year ending on the first day of January eighteen hundred and sixty-six.

Sums appro-
priated.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland.* That for the expenditures in the support of the Government, for the year ending on the first day of January, eighteen hundred and sixty-six, the following sums of money, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated, in addition to the appropriations made under chapter three hundred and seventy-four, of eighteen hundred and sixty-four, that is to say, for the salary of the Governor in addition to the sum already appropriated, four hundred dollars; for the salary of the Commissioner of the Land Office, additional twelve hundred and fifty dollars; for the salary of the State Librarian, additional five hundred dollars; for the salaries of the Judges of the Court of Appeals, five thousand dollars; for the salaries of the Judges of the first twelve circuits, sixteen thousand dollars additional; for the salary of the Judge of the thirteenth judicial circuit, five hundred dollars additional; for salary of the Judge of the Superior Court of Baltimore city, five hundred dollars additional; for the salary of the Judge of the Court of Common Pleas of Baltimore city, five hundred dollars additional; for the salary of the Judge of the Criminal Court, Baltimore city, one thousand dollars additional; for the salaries of the five additional Judges elected under the present Constitution, from the date of their qualification, to January first eighteen hundred and sixty-five, fifteen hundred dollars; for the salary of an additional Clerk to the Comptroller, twelve hundred dollars; for the salary of the Adjutant General of Militia, one thousand dollars additional; for the salaries of the five Inspectors of Tobacco, six thousand five hundred dollars; for insurance on the Tobacco Warehouses, one hundred dollars; to Colleges, Academies and Schools, twenty-seven thousand dollars; to the Education of the Indigent
