

sums of money herein appropriated for the objects and purposes specified to or upon the order of the person or persons, bodies politic or corporate, severally entitled thereto; and that the several public officers to whom the same or any part thereof may be paid, shall render quarterly to the Comptroller accounts of the expenditures thereof, with the proper vouchers verified by affidavit, except such parts thereof as may be paid for or on account of salaries fixed by the Constitution and laws of this State.

Sec. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall In force. take effect from the first day of April, eighteen hundred and sixty-five.

CHAPTER 169.

AN ACT to regulate and make uniform the compensation of the Judges of the Orphans' Courts of the several counties and city of Baltimore. Passed March 24, 1866.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That all the sections of the several Articles of the Code of Public Local Laws relating to the pay and mileage of the Judges of the Orphans' Courts of this State, be and the same are hereby repealed. Sections repealed.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the following Sections added sections be added to the ninety-third Article of the Code of Public General Laws to be arranged under the sub-title, "Orphans' Courts," in said Article and to follow section two hundred and twenty-seven of said Article, "the Judges of the Orphans' Courts of the several counties shall each receive the sum of four dollars, and the Judges of the Orphans' Court of Baltimore city shall receive six dollars, for every days attendance upon the sessions of said court, to be paid by the counties and city of Baltimore respectively."
