hundred and five, three hundred and six, three hundred and seven, three hundred and eight, three hundred and nine, three hundred and ten, three hundred and eleven, three hundred and twelve, three hundred and thirteen, three hundred and fourteen, three hundred and fifteen, three hundred and sixteen, three hundred and seventeen, three hundred and eighteen, three hundred and nineteen, three hundred and twenty, three hundred and twenty-one, three hundred and twenty-two, three hundred and twenty-three, three hundred and twenty-four, three hundred and twenty-five, three hundred and twenty-six, three hundred and twenty-seven, three hundred and twenty-eight and three hundred and twenty-nine, of Article-four of the Code of Public Local Laws of Baltimore city. entitled, "Fish," and the sections enacted by the act of eighteen hundred and sixty-four, chapter three hundred and sixty-nine, be and the same are hereby repealed, and the following sections relating to the inspection of salted fish in the city of Baltimore, be enacted in lieu thereof, to be arranged under the head of "Fish," in said Article:

293. The Governor, by and with the advice Inspector to be appointed. and consent of the Senate, shall bi-annually appoint an Inspector of salted fish in the city of Baltimore.

294. The Inspector so appointed, shall enter into bond to the State of Maryland, with good and sufficient securities to be approved of and retained by the Treasurer, in the penal sum of two hundred dollars conditioned for the true and faithful discharge of his duties as Inspector.

To enter into

- 295. It shall be the duty of said Inspector to Duty. inspect all salted fish except such as have been inspected agreeably to the laws of the county or State from which they came.
- 296. The said Inspector shall receive for the Compensation. inspection of each barrel, half barrel, or tierce of herrings, five cents; for each barrel, half barrel or tierce of shad, fifteen cents; and for each kit, or quarter barrel of herrings or shad, three cents.
