## CHAPTER 2.

AN ACT to repeal section seven, (7,) of Article seven, (7,) of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to the Circuit Court for Carroll county, and the manner and times of holding the terms thereof, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Repealed.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the seventh (7) section of Article seven (7) of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to the Circuit Court for Carroll county, and the manner and times of holding the terms thereof, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted, so as to read as follows:

87. The next session of the Circuit Court for Carroll county, shall commence on the second Monday in May next, instead the first Monday in April next, as now provided by law, and all process and writs original, *mesne* or judicial, now issued from said court, purporting to be returnable on the first Monday in April next, shall be returnable on the second Monday in May next, and have the same validity and effect when so returned, as if originally issued returnable on the second Monday in May next, and all subsequent sessions of said court, now prescribed by law to commence and be held at Westminster on the the first Monday in April, and the first Monday in September, in each and every year, shall commence and be held at Westminster on the second Monday in May, and the second Monday in November, respectively, and all writs and process shall be made returnable accordingly.
