

CHAPTER 3.

AN ACT to repeal section twelve of an act passed ^{Passed Jan. 25, 1865.} January session, eighteen hundred and sixty-four, chapter three hundred and eighty-one entitled, an Act to Incorporate the Merchants' and Mechanics' Fire Insurance Company of Baltimore, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section twelve of the Act to Incorporate the Merchant's and Mechanic's Fire Insurance Company of Baltimore be and the same is hereby repealed. ^{Repealed.}

SEC. 2. *Be it enacted,* That no stockholder or other member of this association, shall be answerable in his person or his individual property, for any contracts or agreements of said association, or for any loss, deficiencies or failures of the capital stock of this association, but the whole of the capital stock, together with all property, rights and credits belonging thereunto, and nothing more shall at any time be answerable for the demand against the said association. ^{Individual property not answerable.}

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall be in effect from the date of its passage. ^{In force.}

CHAPTER 4.

A Bill entitled, AN ACT to alter and change the name of Charles Sands to that of Carlos Sales. ^{Passed Jan. 27, 1865.}

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That from and after the passage of this Act the name of Charles Sands, of the city of Baltimore, be and the same is hereby altered and changed to that of Carlos Sales. ^{Name changed}
