

Sec. 21. *And be it further enacted*, That this act <sup>In force.</sup> shall continue and be in force until the year eighteen hundred and eighty-five, and until the end of the next session of the General Assembly which shall take place thereafter.

Sec. 22. *And be it enacted*, That the General <sup>Reservation</sup> Assembly reserves to itself the right to alter, amend or repeal this act at pleasure.

### CHAPTER 37.

AN ACT to alter and change the name of Mary <sup>Passed March</sup> Hicks, of Caroline county, to that of Fannie <sup>8, 1865.</sup> Honora Eaton.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assem-* <sup>Name changed</sup> *bly of Maryland*, That on and after the passage of this act, the name of Mary Hicks, of Caroline county, be and the same is hereby altered and changed to that of Fannie Honora Eaton.

### CHAPTER 38.

AN ACT to change the name of Fannie Parker <sup>Passed March</sup> to that of Fannie Parker <sup>8, 1865.</sup> Roelky.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly* <sup>Name changed</sup> *of Maryland*, That the name of Fannie Parker, of Baltimore city, be and the same is hereby changed to that of Fannie Parker Roelky.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall <sup>In force.</sup> take effect from its passage.
