

CHAPTER 41.

AN ACT to make valid the official acts of Justices of the Peace and Constables who failed to qualify under the New Constitution within the required time, and who have been re-appointed and since qualified according to law.

Passed March
8, 1865.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland.* That all the official acts of Justices of the Peace and Constables of this State who failed to qualify within the time required by the present Constitution, and who have been re-appointed to said offices respectively and since qualified as required by said Constitution and laws, be and the same are hereby made legal and valid in all respects as if the said Justices of the Peace and Constables had been legally qualified and authorized to perform such official acts at the times said acts and each of them were performed.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted;* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 42.

A SUPPLEMENT to an act to incorporate the Dulaney's Valley and Sweet Air Turnpike Company, passed January session eighteen hundred and sixty-four, chapter one hundred and eighty-five.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland.* That the Dulaney's Valley and Sweet Air Turnpike Company, in Baltimore county, be and are hereby authorized and empowered to construct a turnpike road from some point on the line of their road as located at or near Sweet Air to the upper Cross Roads in Harford county, and are
