Sec. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That said company be empowered to increase their capital stock to forty thousand dollars, (\$40,000.)

May change
location.

Sec. 3. *And be it further enacted*, That the Board of Directors of said company be and are hereby authorized from time to time to change the location of their toll gates as the necessities or convenience of said company may require.

Time of elec-
tion of officers.

Sec. 4. *And be it further enacted*, That the election of the officers for the management of said company shall be held on the second Monday of January, in each and every year, at such place as the Board of Directors may appoint.

Sec. 5. *And be it further enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the day of its passage.

CHAPTER 43.

Passed March
9, 1865.

AN ACT appropriating a sum of money to pay Job Evans and Son a sum of money for altering and fitting up five Committee Rooms in the State House.

Authorized to
pay.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Treasurer is hereby directed to pay, on the warrant of the Comptroller, to Job Evans and Son, the sum of five hundred and eighty dollars and forty-five cents, in full, for altering and fitting five Committee Rooms in the State House, in the year eighteen hundred and sixty three.

In force.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from its passage.
