SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly Amended and re-enacted. of Maryland, That section one hundred and thirtyfive of Article twenty-one of the Code of Public Local Laws, be amended and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

135. They may regulate by ordinance, the mar- May rent stalls ket in said town, appoint an Inspector of said and Town Hall market, assign his duties and allow him a reasonable salary; and may authorize him, under their control and direction, to rent out for the benefit of the Corporation, the butcher stalls in, and the benches in and about said market house. They may also lease the hall, now known as the Town Hall, for a period, not at any one time, exceeding fifteen years.

SEC. 2. Be it enacted, That this act shall take In force. effect from the day of its passage.
