and empowered, after having cancelled by payment, all of its liabilities, to donate to the institution known as the "Aged Men's Home," of Baltimore city, all of said "Baltimore United Fire Department," bonds, stocks, or other securities, and all other properties and effects of whatsoever kind, of which it may be the owner, as well as the interest accruing, or that may hereafter accrue on any of its stocks, bonds, and other securities.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That the said "Baltimore United Fire Department," after having organization. disposed of its properties and effects, as provided in the foregoing section, may dissolve its organization and surrender its charter.

CHAPTER 58.

AN ACT to authorize the Commissioners of Kent Passed March 20, 1866. county to levy a certain sum of money upon the taxable property of said county, for the improvement of the navigation of the mouth of Fairlee creek, in said county.

SECTION. 1. Be it enacted by the General Assem- Commissionbly of Maryland, That the Commissioners of Kent to levy a sum county are authorized and empowered to levy upon of money. the taxable property of said county a sum of money not exceeding one thousand dollars, for the purpose of improving the navigation of the mouth of Fairlee creek, in said county, the said money to be expended under the direction of G. D. S. Handy, William P. Francis and William Tomlinson.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall In force. take effect from the date of its passage.
