

## CHAPTER 83.

Passed Jan.  
25, 1864.

AN ACT to add new sections to Article two of the Code of Public Local Laws for Anne Arundel county, to authorize the County Commissioners of said county, in certain cases, to levy taxes to build school houses.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the following sections, under the head of "County Commissioners," be added to Article two of the Code of Public Local Laws for Anne Arundel county, to authorize and empower the County Commissioners of said county in certain cases to levy taxes to build school houses :

227. The County Commissioners of Anne Arundel county are authorized in their discretion, upon the recommendation of the School Commissioners of said county, to levy taxes upon the assessable property of Anne Arundel county, to erect and repair school houses ; *provided,* that no school district, in any instance, shall be entitled to receive more than one hundred and fifty dollars, and the same to be applied under the supervision and direction of the School Commissioners of said county.
