CHAPTER 86.

AN ACT to allow William H. Protzman, administrator of Joseph G. Protzman, late of Washington county, deceased, further time to complete his collections. Passed Jan. 27, 1864.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That William H. Protzman, administrator of Joseph G. Protzman, late of Washington county, deceased, ~~be~~, and he is hereby authorized and empowered to collect any taxes or balances of taxes now remaining due to, and uncollected by the said Joseph G. Protzman, late collector of State and county taxes for the years eighteen hundred and fifty-six and eighteen hundred and fifty-seven, for Washington county, in the same manner and with the same powers and privileges as he (the said Joseph G. Protzman) had and possessed as collector aforesaid, and as are now allowed by existing laws in such cases made and provided. Time extended.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from its passage, and continue in force for two years. In force.
