CHAPTER 95.

AN ACT to alter and change the name of Alfred Johnson to William Fell Johnson. Passed Feb. 11, 1864.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the name of Alfred Johnson, a native of the State of Maryland, and now a resident therein, be and the same is hereby altered and changed to William Fell Johnson, and it shall be lawful for the said Alfred Johnson at all times hereafter to be called and known by, and hold and use the name of, William Fell Johnson, and by the name of William Fell Johnson to purchase, sell, convey or devise, and to sue and be sued in any court of law or equity. Name changed.

CHAPTER 96.

AN ACT to incorporate the Liberty and New Windsor Turnpike Road Company, in Frederick and Carroll counties. Passed Feb. 15, 1864.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Henry Baker, Dr. Simms, William Hobbs, Henry C. Gaither, Isaac C. Nicodemus, Joel Roop, William Ecker, Daniel Engel, A. H. Baker, and Joseph Stouffer, be and they are hereby incorporated a body politic, for making a Incorporated.
