

CHAPTER 101.

Passed Feb. 8, 1864. AN ACT to change and alter School Districts number twenty and number twenty-one, in Caroline county, so as to attach the following described district to the Opossum Hill district, and electing Trustees for the same.

School districts changed. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That school districts numbers twenty and twenty-one, in Caroline county, be changed and altered so as to attach the following described district to the Opossum Hill school district, to wit: Commencing at the new road in district number twenty, near Toy Dwiggen's, with said road to Ezekiel Eaton's; thence by and including Henry Bowdle's farm; thence to the branch leading to Smith's mill pond; then up said branch to the Meloney farm, and including said farm; then from the northwest boundary of said farm, in a southwesterly direction, until it intersects the main road leading from Potter's Landing, to Hubbard's Cross Roads, between the farm whereon Thomas Bea-champ, Sr., now resides, and his out farm next the said Cross Roads.

Power to elect new Board. Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the legal voters of the district so formed by the foregoing section shall have the power to elect a new Board of Trustees for said school district.

In force. Sec. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
