Sec. 7. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 111.

AN ACT to add a new section to Article seventeen of the Code of Public Local Laws entitled, "Queen Anne's county," to authorize the County Commissioners of the said county to have a bridge built over Island creek, in said county. Passed Mar. 2, 1864.

SECTION. 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the following section be added to Article seventeenth of Public Local Laws entitled, "Queen Anne's county." Section enacted.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's county are hereby authorized and empowered to have a bridge built over Island creek from the shore of the Messrs. Bookers to the opposite shore of Edward H. Leaverton, if in their judgment the public interest and convenience requires the same to be erected, and to have the cost of the same levied upon the assessable property of Queen Anne's county. Powers granted.

Sec. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.
