filed.

Sec. 15. The President, Vice President, Visitors and Physicians who may be hereafter elected or appointed shall take, subscribe and file said oath before they proceed to exercise any of the functions of their office or appointment.

In force.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the day of its passage, and the Clerk of the Superior Court shall communicate to the Governor the names of all the officers of said hospital, who shall file said oath and the date at which it was filed.

CHAPTER 130.

Passed March
7, 1864.

AN ACT to repeal the act passed at the called session held at Frederick, April eighteen hundred and sixty-one, chapter ninety-seven, entitled an act to amend the seventy-fifth Article of the Code of Public General Laws, by adding a section to authorize the removal of equity causes in the Superior Court for Baltimore city and in the Circuit Court for Baltimore, from one to the other of said Courts.

Repealed.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the act of the called session of eighteen hundred and sixty-one, chapter ninety-seven, providing for the removal of equity causes in the Superior Court for Baltimore city and in the Circuit Court for Baltimore city, from one to the other of those Courts, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from its passage.
