

be made, which inquisition shall be returned to the office of the Clerk of Baltimore county, and either party shall have the right of appeal to the County Court, from the verdict or finding of said jury, within thirty days from the date of said verdict, and in the event of an appeal being taken by either party, it shall in no way retard the progress or making of said road, but they, the plaintiff and defendant, shall be bound by the award of the said Circuit Court of Baltimore County.

Sec. 17. *And be it enacted*, That all persons, whatsoever, traveling on said turnpike road, shall be chargeable with tolls, as provided in section tenth of this act; *provided*, that no funeral procession, or persons passing to or from church, or from one part of their farm to another part thereof, shall be chargeable with tolls.

Sec. 18. *And be it enacted*, That nothing herein contained shall be construed to authorize said company to exercise banking privileges; and the Legislature reserves the right to amend, alter, or repeal this act at pleasure.

## CHAPTER 186.

AN ACT to repeal sections one hundred and ninety-seven, two hundred and three and two hundred and seven of the eighth Article of the Code of Public Local Laws entitled, "Cecil county," relating to Schools in said county, and re-enact the same, with amendments.
