

## CHAPTER 22.

Passed Feb. 9, 1864. AN ACT to make valid a deed from George Forthman and Susannah Forthman, his wife, of Franklin county and State of Pennsylvania, to Frederick Forthman; bearing date upon the twenty-first day of February, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-three.

Deed made valid. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the deed from George Forthman and Susannah Forthman, his wife, of Franklin county and State of Pennsylvania, to Frederick Forthman, bearing date upon the twenty-first day of February, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-three, be and the same is hereby made as valid and effectual as if the acknowledgment thereof by George Forthman and Susannah Forthman, his wife, had been duly made before a Notary Public, as required by the laws of this State, instead of a Justice of the Peace, and certified to by a court of record and of law, and had annexed thereto the proper certificate of the Notary Public or Clerk of such court, in due form of law.

In force.. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 23.

Passed Feb. 9, 1864. AN ACT to make certain improvements in the vicinity of the "State Live Stock Scales," in Baltimore county.
