CHAPTER 210.

Passed March
8, 1864.

AN ACT to authorize the Commissioners of Baltimore county to pay such sum as shall be necessary to supply the office of the Register of Wills of Baltimore county, with Record Books, and to levy therefor.

SECTION. 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Commissioners of Baltimore county be and they are hereby authorized and directed to pay to the Register of Wills for Baltimore county, such sum of money not exceeding three hundred dollars as shall appear to them, upon exhibit of a certificate signed by the Judges of the Orphans' Court of Baltimore county, to have been actually laid out and expended by the said Register of Wills, for the supply to his office of proper books of record for the safe preservation of copies of all the original papers now required by law to be recorded in said office, and the said Commissioners are hereby authorized and directed to levy for said amount.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from and after the day of its passage.
